Q: What does your organization do?

A: We are an all volunteer 501c3 non profit whose mission is to support Central Florida animal welfare by fundraising for local nonprofit and government agencies that are dedicated to Shelter/Rescue, Spay/Neuter, or Community education programs.

A: We don't have a shelter. We are fundraisers. We function like the United Way for local animal welfare. We raise money throughout the year and then, through a grant application process, make awards to local nonprofit or government agencies for specific animal welfare projects.

A: Without a parent you need to be 16; from 10 to 15 you need a parent with you

A: Any nonprofit or government agency in Orange, Seminole, Osceola, Lake, or Volusia County that is dedicated to Spay/Neuter, Shelter/Rescue, or Community Education programs
